Payment Coupons

Enclosed with this newsletter are your payment coupons for 2021 along with a statement for 2020 that shows your history through the statement date. The items dated on the first of the month are your regular monthly billing. These invoices are not actually mailed. We use payment coupons instead of mailing monthly invoices to try to hold down costs for the District as much as possible. Other items on the statement may be water overage billing or storage lot billing for those who used the storage lot in 2020.

Sale of Lots

This year the District opened up the sale of three vacant lots to the public. The successful bidders were two members of the District. The storage lot has been purchased by Ray Hawk. Mr. Hawk will continue to utilize the space as a storage lot. **Anyone interested in spaces in the storage lot is encouraged to call Mr. Hawk at 307-680-0229.**

The funds from the sale of the properties totaled \$61,700. These funds will be deposited into the District's accounts in the WyoStar investment program which has historically provided a higher earning rate than other accounts. These funds are for the purpose of maintaining the District's water and sewer systems and for paying for long term costs such as the abandonment of the wastewater lagoon when the District connects to City Sewer.

The Board stays in regular communications with City Council members on behalf of Crestview residents to ensure the eventual transition to City sewer and water are done seamlessly and as economically as possible for residents.


